

Advanced Medication Reconciliation Enhancements

Releasing a medication on hold

Users can now release a home medication from **Hold** status in Advanced Medication Reconciliation. Selecting to **Change** a home medication that is in **Hold** status gives users the option of either renewing the medication or releasing the medication from **Hold** status.




Figure 1: Releasing a home medication Hold in Advanced MedRec

Advanced Medication Reconciliation Fixes

Accepting an outpatient order copied from inpatient in the Advanced MedRec dialog

When the **BEHOORPA CLINICAL INDICATOR** XPAR is set to **Required** for outpatient medications and the user copies an inpatient order to outpatient in the Advanced Medication Reconciliation dialog, the user can now successfully accept the order.

Required action: Test by copying an inpatient order to outpatient in the Advanced Medication Reconciliation dialog when the **BEHOORPA CLINICAL INDICATOR** XPAR is set to **Required** for outpatient medications. Confirm the ability to accept the order.

Auto-populating the Schedule field; free text schedules populate schedule list

The **Schedule** field now auto-populates when a user begins to type the schedule into the **Inpatient/Outpatient** and **Home Medication** dialogs in the Advanced Medication Reconciliation module. The **Home Medication** dialog now appropriately accepts free-text schedules.

Required action: Test using the **ADD Medication** function for inpatient/outpatient and home medications in Advanced Medication Reconciliation. In addition, add new home medication orders with free-text schedules and pre-defined schedules via the **Nursing Medication** and **Provider Medication Reconciliation** dialogs.
