Pharmacy

Fill on request medications correctly charge on dispense

Medications associated with an orderable item that is configured with a Fill on Request schedule type only charge on dispense and not when administered in BCMA.

Required action: Test by ordering medications associated with an orderable item configured using a Fill on Request schedule type, e.g., eye drops, creams. Order from both CareVue and the Pharmacy application. Verify the medication orders in Pharmacy and assign a pre-exchange dose. Administer doses of the medication via BCMA. Verify that the medications are charged on dispense and not on administration.

Outpatient account number prompt consistently displays

The patient account number prompt now consistently displays prior to order entry. The prompt displays all account numbers ever used for the patient, from which the user can choose one. The prompt displays before each order entered for the patient, regardless of whether multiple orders are entered within the same session. The charge message generated by the order entry or administration correctly includes the selected account number.
