

How to determine the drugs associated with an allergy (including food allergies)

1. Go to FileMan

Enter or Edit File Entries
Print File Entries
Search File Entries
Modify File Attributes
Inquire to File Entries
Utility Functions ...
Data Dictionary Utilities ...
Transfer Entries
Other Options ...

2. Select Inquire to File Entries

- a. At the "Output from what File:" prompt, enter "GMR ALLERGIES"
- b. At the "Select GMR ALLERGIES NAME:" prompt, enter the allergy you wish to check.
- c. Note the entries in the DRUG INGREDIENT field (this is a multiple, so can contain more than one entry).

Select OPTION: INQUIRE TO FILE ENTRIES

3. Select Inquire to File Entries

- a. At the "Output from what File:" prompt, enter "DRUG INGREDIENTS"
- b. At the "Select DRUG INGREDIENTS NAME:" prompt, enter the DRUG INGREDIENT from Step 2.

- c. **Note the entries in the DRUG IDENTIFIER field (this is a multiple, so can contain more than one entry).**

Select OPTION: inqUIRE TO FILE ENTRIES

4. Select Search File Entries

- a. At the "Output from what File:" prompt, enter "VA PRODUCT"
- b. At the "SEARCH FOR VA PRODUCT FIELD:" prompt, enter "SERVICE CODE"
- c. At the "CONDITION:" prompt, enter "EQUALS"
- d. At the "EQUALS:" prompt, enter the following
 - i. Note the result of the output of Step 3 above.
 - ii. If there are four digits after the "A", then enter "60" plus the four digit number (for example, the first entry above is 2054A8303. "608303" would be entered at the "EQUALS:" prompt.
 - iii. If there are five digits after the "A", then enter "6" plus the five digit number.
- e. <CR> until you get to the "First Print FIELD:" prompt, and enter "NAME".
- f. The name of the drug product will print.

Select VA FileMan Option: Search File Entries

Output from what File: VA PRODUCT// (22019 entries)

-B- SEARCH FOR VA PRODUCT FIELD:
