How to add the Provider Security Key to a User

For a user to be considered a provider, they must posses the correct Security Keys. These keys include ORES and PROVIDER. If they do not have the PROVIDER Security Key, they will not be allowed to be an encounter provider, which would not allow them to enter orders under their name.

1. Log into CareVue and select an active inpatient. To add a provider as the encounter provider, click in the Visit Encounter box (yellow box, color may vary by site).
